DeLoG’s upcoming Joint Learning event will provide insights on the **nexus between local governance and sustaining peace in fragile and conflict-affected settings**.

The course is structured along three main components:

- Overview of the local governance and sustaining peace nexus
- Local governance for service delivery
- Local governance for social cohesion.

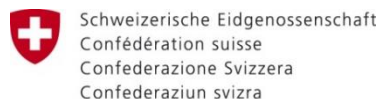
The course will allow for a mix of expert and practitioner presentations as well as provide room for knowledge and experience sharing from the donor’s perspective and content related and informal networking between participants.

The **target group** is staff (headquarters and practitioners in the field) from DeLoG member organizations who work in/on/around local governance and sustaining peace in fragile and conflict-affected settings. The number of participants is limited to 30.

The training will be a 4-day in-person training, taking place **on 12-15 March 2019 in Brussels**, at the premises of the Enabel.

This course, like all courses conducted by DeLoG, is free of charge. Participants are responsible for covering travel and accommodation expenses. The course language is English. **Application will be open on the DeLoG website from December 28 to January 16, 2019**. Selected applicants will be informed by January 23.
